THE RETREAT OPERATES A MULTIFACETED EDUCATION PROGRAM SERVING THE COMMUNITY VIA WORKSHOPS AND PRESENTATIONS ON TOPICS SUCH AS BULLYING, CYBER-SAFETY, HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS, TEEN DATING AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AS WELL AS SEXUAL VIOLENCE PREVENTION.

THE RETREAT PROVIDES IN-SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY VIOLENCE PREVENTION EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FOR SCHOOLS, COMMUNITY GROUPS AND WORKPLACES ON ABUSE RELATED TOPICS, INCLUDING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS, HARRASSMENT AND BULLYING. RETREAT CLIENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO VISIT THE STORE TO ACCESS AND ACQUIRE, AT NO COST, INTERVIEW CLOTHING, FURNITURE, AND HOUSEHOLD ITEMS THEY NEED TO START A NEW LIFE THAT IS FREE FROM VIOLENCE.

THE RETREAT'S HOUSING PROGRAMS PROVIDE FOCUSED SUPPORTIVE SERVICES THAT FOSTER INDEPENDENT AND VIOLENCE FREE LIVING. SERVICES INCLUDE CASE MANAGEMENT, COUNSELING AND ADVOCACY SERVICES, SELF-SUFFICIENCY/LIFE-SKILLS/JOB READINESS TRAINING & MENTORING; AND TEMPORARY, SITUATIONAL CHILD CARE. ADDITIONALLY, THE RETREAT OPERATES A TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM WHICH PROVIDES ASSISTANCE FOR CLIENTS WITH ACCESSING AND MAINTAINING SAFE HOUSING AND SUPPORT SERVICES.
